

2017-18 Winnebago Lakes Planning Project Framework

The project structure shown here provides a framework for the lake management planning process. While the basic structure of the framework will remain consistent throughout the project, Technical Team and Focus Group topics may change as new priorities or topics are realized. The framework was constructed in this way to accommodate the often dynamic process of developing a lake management plan for a large water body system.



Steering Committee: The Steering Committee drives the project and is made up of 16 voting members and 5-8 non-voting advisory members. The Steering Committee will vote to choose three members at large. More than half of the voting Steering Committee members should be present to vote on a topic.

Technical teams are small groups of experienced conservation professionals. A Technical Team will be formed for each management topic. Technical Team leaders (one from each Team) will serve as voting members on the Steering Committee.

Focus Groups are groups of stakeholders including members of the public. Technical teams help to facilitate Focus Groups and serve as a communication link between the Focus Groups and Steering Committee.
