Our Water is Worth Protecting

Fox-Wolf Watershed Alliance is working to protect and restore the water resources of the Fox-Wolf River basin.

We take a holistic approach to watershed management, working across traditional boundaries and priorities to improve water quality. We work at the scale of the entire watershed, because all of our waters are connected. A key component to our approach is engaging a wide variety of partners to maximize our impact.

Our vision is to have:

- Waters that support their full range of uses with no waters on the impaired waters list
- Public awareness of and support for water resources
- Research that increases our understanding of the ecosystem and identifies cost-effective solutions to its problems
- An adequate monitoring program in place to evaluate water quality



The annual Farmer Roundtable provides opportunities for farmers to learn from other farmers about what is working locally for soil health. The program is held at two locations each spring-once in the Keepers of the Fox region, and once in the Winnebago Waterways region. Over 100 farmers and conservation professionals attend each event.

Volunteers visit their boat launch at least three times a year, between April and October. All volunteers will be trained on how to:

- Look for aquatic invasive species at boat launches
- Remove plants from boat launch area
- Remove litter around boat launches
- Report any issues with the boat launch or surrounding areas
